

Granite Technical Institute Dress Code

The Granite Technical Institute takes pride in the appearance and conduct of the students who attend here. We are a professional training program with the expectation that our students will conduct themselves accordingly. For this reason, the Granite Technical Institute has adopted a dress code that reflects the nature of our mission. Our desire is to promote effective learning, increase safety and security, and to avoid distractions. Students are expected to abide by the following standards.

- Spandex and other types of revealing clothing are unacceptable.
- All tops and/or pants must cover the mid-section. No midriff baring shirts are allowed.
- Pants/skirts/shorts must be worn with no underwear showing, whether sitting or standing.
- Shorts and skirts, when worn, must be long enough to be considered appropriate for professional/business attire.
- No “sagging”. Underwear must be covered at all times.
- No shear fabric will be allowed.
- Accessories such as chains and spikes are not allowed.
- All tops must have straps. All straps must lie on the shoulders. No spaghetti strap, halter, tube, one-sided, backless, or revealing tops allowed, unless covered with a jacket or full-size shirt.
- Items depicting vulgarity, profanity, harassment, suggestive/obscene slogans, violence, weapons, illegal/criminal activity, gang related items, or promotion of alcohol, tobacco, or illegal substances, such as drugs, are not allowed.
- No hats, bandannas, sweat-bands, or other headgear should be worn.
